UMBC's IRB is registered to review Social-Behavioral-Educational research and does not represent the expertise necessary to serve as the Reviewing IRB for clinical trial human subjects research studies.

****The full board letter depends on the determination of the IRB Committee. Determinations are typically: project approval, project approval with conditions, project tabled for modifications, or project disapproval.**
